1 <sup>st</sup>	Pray for patience in homes and families, as parents struggle with home-schooling and
	children with isolation and restriction; and for the presence of Christ in the home
2 <sup>nd</sup>	Remember the Christian Church throughout the world, and especially the persecuted
	church in China, where the government has been removing the Cross from places of
	worship as part of an attempt to suppress Christian faith. Pray for courage for Chinese
	Christians, and for agencies advocating liberty of religion, like Open Doors
3 <sup>rd</sup>	Focus today on the spiritual and physical health of a world struggling with COVID-19. Pray
	for BMS workers Judy Cook in Thailand, caring for children with disabilities, and Mark and
	Andrea Hotchkin, doctors in Chad, a very poor and disturbed country. Ask God to protect
	them from disease and danger and enable them to communicate the love of Christ and the
	truth of the gospel
4 <sup>th</sup>	Pray for sick and elderly folk in our local care homes or isolated at home, especially those
	who are approaching the end of life, that they may be pointed towards eternal life.
	Remember also their carers and families at this difficult time, that they may be given
	strength and all they need to make the homes happy, peaceful, & free from undue anxiety
5 <sup>th</sup>	Give thanks to God for the news that there is now a drug capable of mitigating the effects of
	COVID-19 and saving lives. Pray for the researchers who are seeking a safe and effective
	vaccine which can defeat the disease entirely. Pray for the leaders of the nation that they
	may depend on God for wisdom as they deal with economic and health problems at the
	same time. Pray for all nations and their leaders that the day may come in which all nations
	may acknowledge Christ as Lord
6 <sup>th</sup>	Pray for CBCs Hope Space to be a space where those who don't know Jesus yet will find the
	hope, the peace and the salvation that he brings
7 <sup>th</sup>	Give thanks to God for his sacrifice for each one of us
8 <sup>th</sup>	Pray for our ongoing connection with one another as a church family
9 <sup>th</sup>	Pray for Clevedon Market's traders today, that they would be encouraged and rewarded in
	their work and that they might make good connections with our chaplaincy team there
10 <sup>th</sup>	Pray for those who have lost work during the pandemic, that they would manage financially
	somehow and find a new opportunity as soon as is feasible
11 <sup>th</sup>	Pray for all those who are abused, whether physically or mentally, that they may be able to
	reach out for and be given the help they need
12 <sup>th</sup>	Pray for the many children who have had and continue to have little or no schooling that
	ways may be found to help them to make up for lost time
13 <sup>th</sup>	Pray that as some return to more normal life, there will be no return of COVID-19
14 <sup>th</sup>	Pray for all those throughout the world who are persecuted for their faith that they may
	stand firm and keep on trusting in the Lord
15 <sup>th</sup>	Pray for all those who are still isolated for health reasons that they may not be discouraged
	or downhearted as others have more freedom. May they not take unnecessary risks
16 <sup>th</sup>	Pray for all those who would normally have attended our coffee morning today. Help them
	remember the warm welcome and friendship they found among us and comfort them today
17 <sup>th</sup>	Give thanks to God for all the children in our church family. Pray a blessing on them.
18 <sup>th</sup>	Pray for Mosaic Church – for each person to come to know Jesus a little more today
19 <sup>th</sup>	Pray for parents and families as they embark on the summer holidays together after a long
	period at home, many now with increased financial limitations





20 <sup>th</sup>	Pray for the Alpha course this evening. That guests would experience the Holy Spirit with
	undeniable confidence and trust and that this would lead them to accept Jesus as Lord
21 <sup>st</sup>	Give thanks that God has been, is and will be with us and also for the comfort He has given
	us whilst we have been separated physically from our loved ones
22 <sup>nd</sup>	Pray for staff and residents at Poet's Mews today
23 <sup>rd</sup>	Pray for CBCs Youth Ministry to continue to thrive during this time, helping young people to
	know Jesus, to be discipled and to glorify God
24 <sup>th</sup>	Pray for all those who are on long waiting lists for treatment. For God's protection and
	patience in their waiting
25 <sup>th</sup>	Pray for the businesses on Clevedon's seafront today, for the safety of staff and customers
26 <sup>th</sup>	For guidance for young people and their families who are reliant on assessed exam results
	for their places in Further Education and University
27 <sup>th</sup>	For teachers and other staff who are currently involved in teaching children of Key Workers
	as they face the shape of schools in the future
28 <sup>th</sup>	For staff and residents of Care Homes that they might be kept free from Coronavirus and
	that they may have all the resources they need
29 <sup>th</sup>	For the blessing of the Lord's presence on all those that we would normally have contact
	with at events in the church building, that the Holy Spirit will remind them of conversations
	held in past days
30 <sup>th</sup>	For a special blessing of the Lord's strength and protection on all the vulnerable people who
	have been 'shielding' over the past months because of the pandemic
