This role is being advertised as a part-time role of 20 hours per week, but we have some flexibility depending on what you are able to offer. The salary is a good competitive package depending on experience.

Many of our activities will mean that this is an in-person role, during the week and on Sunday mornings as part of our church family. You will be expected to be committed to CBC and become a church member with us. There will be times when planning or preparation work can be more flexible and working from home is possible. Our working arrangements will enable us to succeed in a way that works for you.
